



COVID-19 VACCINES

What You Need to Know | February 2021

When can I get the vaccine?

As of January 29, 2021, the government is granting first access to groups at high risk of becoming infected with COVID-19 or who might get very sick if infected. These are mainly health care workers, essential workers, older adults, and people with certain medical conditions.

In **New Jersey**, you can pre-register for the vaccine at covidvaccine.nj.gov or 855-568-0545 (press 8 for Spanish). You will receive an email later to schedule an appointment. You will not have to pay, even if you are uninsured.

Where can I get the vaccine?

Vaccine distribution sites are being set up in every county across New Jersey.

At this time, sites are by appointment only for eligible individuals. A list of sites and appointment information is online at bit.ly/2XXNpSp.
